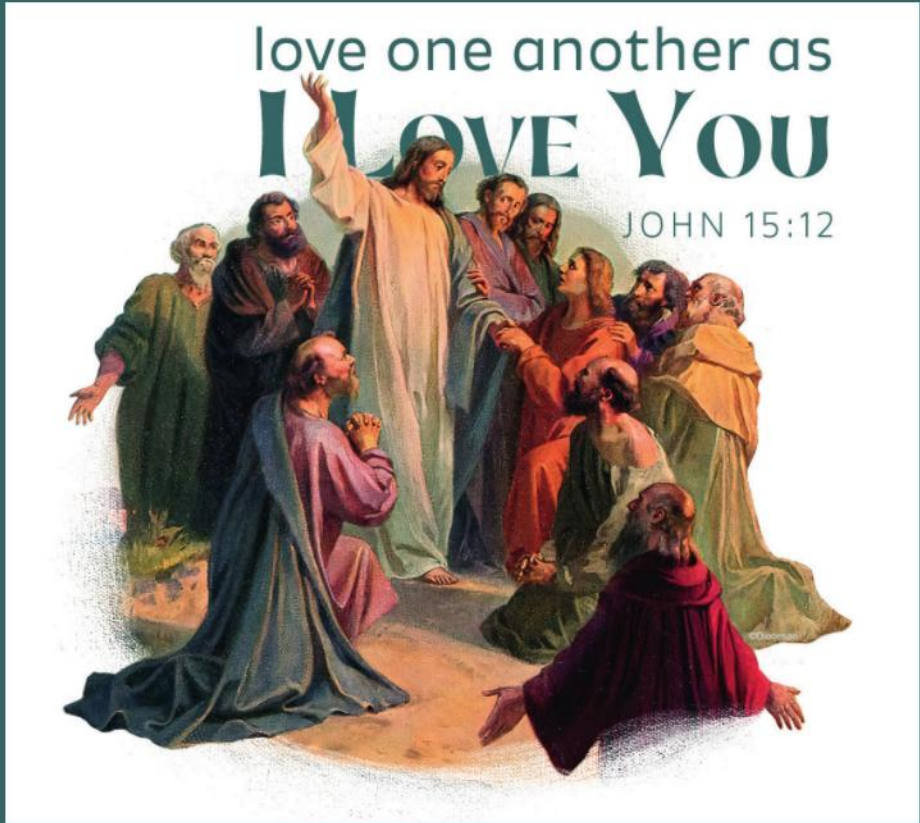

Reflection

Question of the day....my oldest granddaughter, as of last week, has 3,883 pictures and 971 videos on her phone...is that too many? My guess is by the time she looks at all of this stuff, she'll be ready for Social Security!!!

For the readings of the 6th Sunday of Easter, the word, "love" is mentioned a total of 21 times. You don't need to go back and check, I counted it twice to make sure!

One of the songs that I "love" to listen to is L.O.V.E. by Nat King Cole. If you don't know who he is, he was the father of Natalie Cole. If you still don't know, ask your grandparents. If they don't know...ask Google! He has a statement for every letter of the word, "love." "L" - is for the way you look at me; "O" is for the only one I see; "V" is very, very extraordinary and "E" is even more than anyone that you adore.

These are such simple words, but they pack a very powerful message. If we think about the people, we "love," do these words describe my relationship to them? I have been blessed to be married almost 46 years; every time we leave one another or end our telephone conversation, we say the word, "covenant!" One of the many definitions of this word is that we agree we will "love" each other. When we have our disagreements, we know that the other person will not leave because we are in this covenant. The only way this will work is, if and only if, we "love" each other. We both know that, no matter the challenge, neither one of us will leave the other.

The Holy Trinity is in a covenant with us! They will never leave us. We have heard over the last few weeks that Jesus is our shepherd and will never stop looking for us and "loving" us. No human can love us like this!

If we look at those words from Nat King Cole, they certainly describe God's love for us. The letter "L" means He is always looking out for us and knows what's best for us. Will we listen to Him? The letter "O" means He is totally focused on us. Are we focused on Him? The letter "V" means we are unique and extraordinary. Do we believe this? The "E" means His "love" for us never goes away in spite of our actions at times. Doesn't this bring comfort to us in those trying times?

So, with all of the "love" we are receiving, let's go out into the world and spread some of this "love" to others!
